### *What is What's My Business?*

- An authentic and powerful student-led unit in partnership with Australian Lutheran World Service (ALWS)
- An answer to the question "What can I do?" - to help students see they can make a difference
- A chance to help people in need!

### *How does it work?*

- Students learn about the work of ALWS and Savings Groups, which operate in communities to help kickstart small businesses.
- They develop small business ideas, and apply for a \$20 loan to fund their idea from the Year 4 Savings Group
- Then, in a school-based 'market day', sell their product to the local school community
- Students use income to repay loan to the Year 4 Savings Group.
- Students use profits to choose ALWS Gifts of Grace to help communities in need!
